Doubled peer education demand

Tripled crisis support requests (SA)

- 400 counselling sessions for sex workers in NSW
- 1253% increase in sex workers accessing the red book online

Report recommendations:

- Decriminalise all aspects of sex work in all jurisdictions in Australia
- Recognise sex workers and sex worker organisations as leaders, partners and experts
- Provide adequate financial support to sex workers and sex worker peer organisations
- Take a pragmatic evidenceand human rights-based approach to COVID-19 and other public health crisis responses impacting sex workers.

Only industry prohibited in stage 3 federal road map until advocacy reversed the decision

1st fines were sex workers in NSW & QLD when police were given extra COVID powers

July 2020: 50+ sex work related COVID fines in 1 week in Victoria 15 fold increase in non-COVID charges against sex workers in Queensland in the first month back to work

20 sex workers reported human rights abuse by police in QLD

Most sex industry businesses targetted were Asian businesses providing massage and sexual services
