

## SIN needs 2 workers for our new Injecting Drug Use (IDU)/Street Outreach Project!

This is a newly created and funded project to promote the health, rights and well-being of sex workers who inject drugs and/or work on the street. The project will be strongly outreach focused so applicants will need to be prepared to work evenings/nights to provide Clean Needle Program services and high quality peer support, information, and referrals to sex workers in street locales and other sex industry workplaces. SIN works closely with SAVIVE (SA Voice for IV Education), the community program for injectors to ensure services are grounded in the needs & interests of people who inject drugs.

## Position 1

IDU/Street Outreach Project Worker- Social & Community Services Award (SACS) Level 4 (\$39,865 per year, full-time) working 0.6 FTE 22.5 hours/3 days per week *Position 2* 

IDU/Street Outreach Worker- SACS Level 3 (\$35,458 full-time) working 0.4 FTE (15 hours/2days per week)

No formal qualifications are necessary for either of these positions however, like all SIN staff/volunteer positions, sex worker experience is essential. Personal experience of injecting drug use will also be highly regarded. Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander people are also encouraged to apply. SIN is a community based organisation that highly values the wealth of knowledge, skills and experience that being a 'peer' brings to our work.
